The 2021 growing season will be remembered for extremely low rainfall and for low yields off the vine. The low yields led to berry flavors that are pronounced and intense. The lack of rainfall resulted in harvest starting earlier than in the past. Harvest kicked off on August 6th, a week earlier than the 2020 season and twenty days before 2019. The remainder of the harvest season was relatively smooth and uneventful. We received our last fruit on October 20th, just in time to miss the massive storm that dropped over 9 inches of rain on parts of California.
