

2021 CALIFORNIA CABERNET SAUVIGNON



WINEMAKER'S NOTES:

The 2021 growing season will be remembered for extremely low rainfall and for low yields off the vine. The low yields led to berry flavors that are pronounced and intense. The lack of rainfall resulted in harvest starting earlier than in past seasons. Harvest kicked off August 6th, a week earlier than the 2020 season and twenty days before 2019.

This Cabernet Sauvignon is perfect for everyday drinking. Enjoy with grilled meats, hearty pasta dishes or a juicy hamburger. It also pairs well with brie or cheddar cheese and with chocolate desserts.

WINE DESCRIPTION:

This wine is a deep ruby color with fruit and spice characteristics. Aromas of blackberry, black cherry and caramel. Juicy flavors of plum, blackberry, and caramel. A well-balanced Cabernet Sauvignon with good acidity, soft tannins and a long, smooth finish.
