## 2023 LODI ZINFANDEL

### The Spirited Flavor of Bourbon Oak Aging

Heavily charred Bourbon oak barrels impart nuanced layers of caramel, vanilla and toasty oak to the wine's naturally intense dark berry character. The result is a robust, deliciously complex and silky-smooth Lodi Zinfandel.

**Wine Description:** Intense and full-bodied with dark red cherry, subtle tannins, and a lingering smoky finish.

**Aromas & Flavors:** Bright raspberry, black cherry, and ripe blackberry with hints of caramel, vanilla, and toasty oak. Drink now through 2030.

**Appellation:** Lodi



**Aging:** Aged on French and American oak, then finished in heavily charred Bourbon barrels.

**Blend:** 93% Zinfandel, 3.9% Petite Sirah, 2.1% Port, 1% Mixed Red

**TA / pH:** .66 (g/100mL) / 3.52

**Alcohol:** 15.5%

**RS:** 1.36 g/100mL
